## Tennessen Warning

The #CarFreeMSP Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") is sponsored by Metro Transit Commuter Programs, in the State of Minnesota, working in conjunction with local and regional government entities and agencies.

If you participate in the Sweepstakes, you will be asked to provide certain information that is classified as private or confidential data under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act. Specifically, we will collect the following information about you: first and last name, email address, residential address, employer or school, and employer or school zip code.

In addition to the above information, we will also collect: (a) your beginning and ending work hours; (b) your current mode of commuting to and from work; (c) the type of rideshare service information you have requested; (d) where you will take your car-free trip; and (e) on what mode of transportation you will be taking your car-free trip.

We collect the information you provide: (1) to administer the Sweepstakes; (2) for statistical evaluation; and (3) to provide you with any information or services related to transportation that you request. The information that we ask you to provide on the entry form is not required by law. Participation in the Sweepstakes is strictly voluntary, and you are not required by law to furnish any of the information requested on the entry form. However, without the requested information, you will not be able to enter the Sweepstakes.

The information you provide will be provided to certain other entities and individuals in order to administer the Sweepstakes. These entities include Move Minneapolis, Move Minnesota, Anoka County Transit - Commute Solutions, Commuter Services (the outreach program of I-494 Corridor Commission), the Minnesota Department of Revenue, and the International Revenue Service. In addition, the information may be shared upon court order or provided to the state or legislative auditor.
